

SOUTH BEACH CHRISTIAN SCHOOL INFORMATION

The following is for the 2022-23 school year.

MISSION

South Beach Christian School (SBCS) equips students to live for the glory of God and the good of others!

GRADES & CLASS SIZE

Preschool (ages 3 & 4) will have 8-10 children per class and grades K-5 will have 10-16 children per class.

Our goal is to add middle and high school classes in the future as we are able.

TUITION

Application fee \$50 and classroom fee \$450

Half Day Preschool

\$3,500 /year \$350/month (10 months)

Full Day Preschool and Grades K-5

\$5,500/year \$550/month (10 months)

Partial scholarships are limited.

CALENDAR

The school year runs from September 2022 through June 2023, Monday through

Thursday. Before and after school care, and Friday enrichment programs are available for an additional fee. Other students from the community may also attend as space allows.

LOCATION

For the first year, the school will be located at Newport Christian Church. South Beach Church will host the school in future years once construction is complete on the new church and school building.

FOOD AND BUSING

Children will bring their own lunches and snacks from home. Daily school bus transportation is not yet available through SBCS; however, reach out to SBCS to explore creative transportation options.

ACCREDITATION

SBCS will pursue accreditation through the Association of Christian Schools International.

SCHOOL GOVERNANCE

SBCS is a private Christian school funded through tuition and private donations. The South Beach Church elder board oversees the school.

TEACHERS & STAFF

Our staff undergo a rigorous and thorough interview process, and have the necessary credentials required for their positions. Teachers are selected because of their deep commitment to Jesus, and their ability to provide excellent instruction to foster a creative and joyful learning environment. All staff and volunteers are aligned with South Beach Church's Statement of Faith.

CURRICULUM

Curriculum and classroom activities are Christian-based and carefully selected by the School Curriculum Committee to meet the needs of a wide-variety of learners. Specialty classes will be integrated into the school day.

VOLUNTEERING

We welcome family, church, and community volunteers. Volunteers who will be working with children are selected after completing an application and a background check.

ENROLLMENT

The first step in the enrollment process is to fill out an application that will be available on April 18th. Decisions will be made by May 31st. Families will be contacted directly regarding their application and the availability of space for their child to attend SBCS. Enrollment may be denied if it is determined that we are not able to serve the needs of your student. We seek to accept all students who are capable of being successful within the program we provide.
